

MANAGING YOUR APPLICATION

for Admission as Mainland Talents and Professionals



When you submit your application you can ask the Immigration Officer to stamp a copy of the **ID990A** as a receipt. An official Acknowledgement Letter, containing the reference number of your case, will follow in about 10 days.

You can now submit any further documents or make enquiries using the reference number supplied.



You should respond quickly to any queries. Your application will be stalled until they hear from you.



Within about 20 days of application, the Immigration Department may write to you seeking further details or documents.



The application can be tracked through the Immigration Department online system.

Whilst not encouraged, you can make phone enquiries. The contact details for the responsible officer can be found in the correspondence you will receive from the Immigration Department.



It can be difficult to get through to your officer sometimes. If you want, you can make a counter enquiry - *but not recommended*. During holiday times processing is longer - *be patient*.
